

## OSTEOLOGY RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP

### APPLICATION GUIDELINES

#### Application requirements:

- Academic affiliation to an institution outside of the country of the research scholarship centre
- 35 years old or younger within the year of application.
- Full time commitment to scholarship (12 months)
- Proficiency in English (spoken and written) – written application and phone interview are decisive

#### Documents required:

- Motivation letter
- Curriculum vitae
- Publication list
- Recommendation letter
- Upon request, the certificate of an internationally recognised language test e.g. TOEFL with a minimum test score of 75 (B2 level)
- Option to return to their home academic institution

#### Application and granting process:

- Application deadline for Scholarships 2021: **1 December 2020**
- Application must be submitted online through THE BOX  
<https://box.osteology.org/User/MyResearch>
- Documents must be in English and in PDF format
- Applicant must prioritise and select only one scholarship centre (no multiple selection)
- Selection of candidates based on complete application and mandatory phone interview
- Notification date: 15 February 2021

#### Start and duration:

- By default, the scholarship starts 1 September 2021 and ends 31 August 2022 and has a duration of 12 months. A different start date may be possible, if an agreement between the scholarship centre leader, the scholar and the Osteology Foundation Office is reached.

#### Financial support:

The Osteology Research Scholarship of 35'000 Swiss Francs will be paid in two instalments:

- 17'500 Swiss Francs after confirmation of the scholarship start
- 17'500 Swiss Francs after 6 months and acceptance of mid-term report
- All taxes, health insurance and travel costs are within in the responsibility of the scholars
