

APPLICATION GUIDELINES - OSTEOLGY RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS

Application requirements:

- Academic affiliation
- 35 years old or younger within the year of application.
- Full time commitment to scholarship (12 months)
- Proficiency in English (spoken and written) – written application and phone interview are decisive
- Note: Applications for Osteology Research Scholarships that are located in the applicant's country are not possible.

Documents required:

- Motivation letter
- Curriculum vitae
- Publication list
- Recommendation letter
- Upon request the certificate of an internationally recognised language test e.g. TOEFL with a minimum test score of 75 (B2 level)
- Option to return to their home academic institution

Application and granting process:

- Online application deadline for Scholarships 2019 is **1 December 2018**
- Documents must be in English and in PDF format
- Applicant must prioritise and select only one scholarship centre (no multiple selection)
- Selection of candidates based on complete application and mandatory phone interview
- Notification date – 15 February 2019

Start and duration:

- The scholarship starts 1 September 2019 and ends 31 August 2020 and has a duration of 12 months, if nothing else is agreed upon between the scholarship centre leader and the scholar. A change of the start date has to be in agreement with the Osteology office.

Financial support:

The 35'000 Swiss Francs Osteology Research Scholarship will be paid in two instalments:

- 17'500 Swiss Francs after confirmation of the scholarship start
- 17'500 Swiss Francs after 6 months and revision of intermediate report
- All taxes, health insurance and travel costs are within in the responsibility of the scholars
