Event

This event is an educational and social gathering of dental health care professionals.

The organiser cannot be held responsible for the correctness of the educational content of the presentations during the event.

Event location

The terms and conditions of the event location apply. With your registration you agree to comply with terms and conditions of the event location during your participation. Participants cannot hold the organiser responsible for any cost incurred through losses or damages caused by participants.

Registration and participation fee

Registration and participation are free of charge. The registration is binding. However, cancellation can be made in writing to events@osteology.org.

An email confirming your successful registration is sent automatically to your indicated email address. The participant warrants to the organisers that the data supplied on the registration form, including the contact data, are correct.

Registrations will always be confirmed. Participations which cannot be accepted owing to lack of space may be put on a waiting list. A decision on these registrations is taken prior to the event.

The organiser reserves the right to refuse participation. In addition, the organisers reserve the right to grant priority to certain registrations. Refused participants will be notified prior to the event.

Personal data

The organisers will enter the data obtained from the registration into a database kept by the organiser for this purpose. By registering for the event, the participant authorises the use and storage of the data supplied by him. The organiser may use these data for the organisation and processing of the event.

Organiser

The organiser reserves the right at all times to change the dates and times of the event specified in the registration form. Moreover, in very exceptional circumstances or if the organisation of the event so requires, the concept of the event may be changed or the event may even be cancelled. In such cases the participant will not be entitled to claim compensation for any costs incurred and/or loss or damage suffered as a result.

In case of concept change or cancellation, the participants will be notified.

Disputes

The conditions of participation and all legal relations which may arise between the organiser on the one hand and the participant on the other will be governed exclusively by Swiss law.

In the event of disputes resulting from the conditions of participation or legal relationships arising from them, the parties will first of all consult together in order to attempt to resolve this dispute by amicable means. If the parties do not succeed in this, a dispute as referred to above will be decided exclusively by the competent court in Lucerne, Switzerland.
