



OSTEOLOGY RESEARCH ACADEMY GRANTS

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Research Academy Grants entitle their recipients to cover the registration fees of the chosen **O**steology **R**esearch **A**cademy (ORA) course. Funding for these Grants is provided by the Geistlich-Stucki foundation.

Awarded Research Academy Grants are only valid for the respective year of application and cannot be transferred to another year or course.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:

- Academic affiliation
- Proficiency in English (spoken and written)

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- Curriculum vitae and publication list maximum two pages
- Graduation diploma maximum two pages
- Recommendation letter **one page**, Times New Roman 12pt, line spacing 1.2, on official letterhead
- Motivation letter **one page**, Times New Roman 12pt, line spacing 1.2, maximum 350 words. Please clearly mention which of the ORA course you want to visit and motivate your choice.

AWARDING CRITERIA:

- Interest in oral tissue regeneration
- Interest and involvement in basic and/or clinical research (as evident from e.g. scientific posters, publications in peer reviewed journal, etc.)
- Recommendation letter
- Expected benefit for the applicant and their research career
- Financial needs will be taken into account

APPLICATION AND GRANTING PROCESS:

- Documents must be in English and uploaded as single documents in PDF format

- Notifications of acceptance/rejection will be sent at least 6 weeks prior to the course

Please note: applicants are encouraged to carefully choose the most suitable ORA, and **apply only to one course at a time**.
